Financials:

*We reviewed the items/events we supported this school year; **total financial contributions were** approximately \$9500:

<u>Future Projects</u>

- *Crushed Rock to help amend base of Gaga Ball pit
- *Paving out back of school
- *Upgrade shed/bigger shed for better/increased bottle collection space
- *Improve the back woods area –upgrade trails in woods leading to outdoor classroom and out/around pond. Nackawic Mill will donate wood chips we need to be able to pick them up. This would be an undertaking for a group of people-- to clean up trails, lay wood chips, and also add interactive elements (i.e.: signs to educate about native species of plants/animals in the area, etc.)

Other items:

*The school hopes to start a warm breakfast program next year. TNT has offered to sponsor a large percentage of this, plus we can get eggs donated through the egg program. In order to offer cooked food on the premises, there must be someone with Food Safety Certification. Mrs. McKeil will be looking into getting certified herself.

*How to encourage new memberships in Friends of KRS? We discussed a short presentation at the "Meet the Teacher" corn boil at the start of the year. Amy is more than willing to speak on our committee's behalf.

*It was decided that this week (May 31) is the last week for Fruit Trays.
